

Purple Heart Project Fact Sheet

What is the Purple Heart Project (PHP)? PHP is a U.S. public charity recognized under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) and is exempt from federal income taxes under IRC 501(c)(3). PHP's U.S. Federal ID / Tax number is 88-2217122. PHP is also nonprofit corporation, incorporated in the state Washington and is a Washington state registered charity.

What is the Mission PHP? The Purple Heart Project's mission is to introduce physically and mentally combat Wounded Warriors still suffering from the negative effects of combat to the peace and joy that can be found through the therapy of traditional hand tool woodworking.

What is the Vision of PHP? We envision a community of combat Wounded Warriors that share the joy and peace found through the bond of woodworking, are connected for life, and know that they are supported and never forgotten.

Who is the PHP? PHP is a small volunteer-run organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors (BOD). The Directors create policy, provide operational and budget oversight, are responsible for the strategic planning, fund raising, and administrative and program functions to execute the Purple Heart Project mission and vision.

How does PHP accomplish its mission? PHP accomplishes our mission by providing selected combat Wounded Warriors with a PHP scholarship to attend one of Rob Cosman's Training the Hand Workshops. Selected combat Wounded Warriors are fully funded for travel, per diem, and tuition to attend one of Rob Cosman's week-long Training the Hand Workshops where they learn the skills of hand tool woodworking. They receive a full handtool kit and a custom-built workbench and continuing support when they return home.

How is PHP funded? PHP does not receive nor seek out any government funding. We are proudly funded by cash and in-kind donations from individuals, corporations, and foundations.
